




Select 'yes' if YOU submitted the proposal for this track. You should not be a reviewer of your own material. Otherwise, select 'no'.

Comments

Add your comments – this is very helpful for discussion with the rest of the committee.

Save

When ready, select at the bottom:

- **Save & Continue Later** – recommended until you've reviewed all in case you want to go back and change your rating.
- **Save & Submit** – this is final, can't edit after this.
- **Cancel** – you'll have to start over.
