- 2. Update on peering and TR-CPS/I2
 - a. Jeff Bartig: There were some routing anomalies beginning about 1:03pm EDT today, likely related to an eBGP peer sending an invalid attribute list that caused some BGP session resets. Affected peers would have seen a drop in I2PX traffic during ~12 minute window. Working with Juniper to determine root cause and how to better protect the network. Suspect a commercial peer sent an invalid advertisement, then later withdrew it.
 - b. Jeff would be interested in hearing about any effects that connectors are seeing.
 - c. Matt V/MCNC saw a decrease in traffic at about that time.
 - d. Matt V/MCNC: are route reflectors used?
 - i. Jeff Bartig: not at the time; currently use a full mesh.
