The Goal

- Provide Regional Networks as USUCAN Program Sponsors a way to extend elements of the NET+ Program to their members and connected institutions
- Add value to your connected members
- Increase the value proposition of connecting through your organization

Key Aspects of the Program -1-

What does it cost a regional network to participate?

Nothing. All Regional networks (or US UCAN Program Sponsors in the state if there is no regional network) can submit list of eligible higher education non profit organizations for participation.

What other requirements are there?

- 1) Complete an application.
- 2) Provide a named program lead contact within the Regional
- 3) Provide (and maintain) a list of eligible higher education institutions
- 4) Support connectivity to those institutions for distribution of services
- 5) Distribute notifications about community webinars and service availability.

Key Aspects of the Program -2-

How does a campus know if they are eligible?

Internet2 has an online lookup on our website where campuses can check their status. It will also provide links to all available service pages. We recommend regionals link to this lookup.

What happens if a campus isn't listed?

The site will direct a campus to contact their Regional Network for more information.

Key Aspects of the Program -3-

What if a regional/US UCAN program sponsor for a campuses state isn't participating?

In Q4 2017/Q1 2018 Internet2 will offer an ability for those institutions to directly register with Internet2. There will be an additional registration fee for those institutions.

What if a single state has multiple regional networks that are are Internet2 connectors?

The Internet2 team, including the U.S. UCAN program office, will work to make sure that any requesting campus is clearly identified with a single sponsor organization so they are not duplicate registered.
